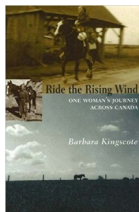

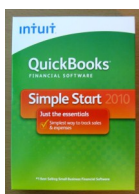
RIDE THE RISING WIND by Barbara Kingscote

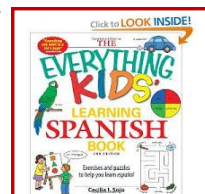

Bringing Good Breast Health To You

The AHS Screen Test Mobile Mammography Clinic will be returning to the Didsbury Hospital on October 12 - 18. Screen Test brings breast cancer screening to women in rural areas with its state-of-the-art mobile mammography clinic.

Why are mammograms important? 1 out of every 8 women in Alberta will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime. Screening mammograms can help find breast cancer early, when treatment options are better. Early detection with mammograms is one of the reasons that most women (90%) are now surviving breast cancer. **Who is eligible for a mammogram?** Women 50 to 74 should plan to be screened every 2 years, and can self-refer. Women 40-49 should discuss the risks and benefits of screening with their health care provider, and require a referral for their first mammogram. 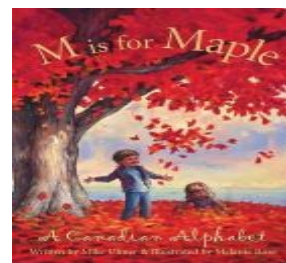


September is library card month. Come in and get your FREE library card or renew your old one! Your library card gives you access to over 300 libraries!
