
BOOK CLUB



Part-time Upgrading Students

Students enrolled in one upgrading class in spring semester can now apply for grant funding from Alberta Works.

Students who apply on or before March 7th will have their tuition deadline deferred. Applications will be accepted after this date; however, students will be required to pay their own tuition and fees by the tuition deadline.

Funding is limited and allocated on a first come first served basis.

Part-time Post-secondary Students

Students planning to take one post-secondary class* in the spring semester can apply for loans and/or grants from Student Aid Alberta. (*pls note that spring practicum classes are generally considered full-time, students can check with us to confirm full/part-time status.)

Students who apply on or before March 7th will have their tuition deadline deferred. Applications will be accepted after this date; however, students will be required to pay their own tuition and fees by the tuition deadline.
