

**OR:** GED with a standard score of 450 in Language Arts: Reading and Writing;

**OR:** Satisfactory results on the BVC Admissions Test

**AND:** Current Police Information Check

**AND:** Current immunization record, if available.

**Description** - The Health Care Aide Certificate provides students with the skills required to provide the personal care for patients in long-term care, acute care and community/home care settings. Health Care Aides help patients with personal care, assisting with mobility and feeding needs, communication, assisting with medication delivery, and generally creating a comfortable environment for them.

This program is a one – semester, 16 – week program. Students will receive instruction in theory and skills using online, blended classroom and laboratory settings, plus clinical experience in a variety of care settings including hospitals, continuing care facilities, community and other health related institutions. This will require traveling from home to a central location (one of Drumheller, Stettler or Olds) for two days of weekly workshops and lab classes. For the first 11 weeks, there will be travel for two days per week for the workshop/lab classes. The final 5 weeks will provide the student with 3 weeks of instructor- led clinical training in a continuing care centre. The final 2 weeks will be in a Hospital, Home Care, or Community Care setting where a Preceptor will mentor the student in their final learning steps. To register or for more information Contact:

### **EMR COURSE COMES TO CREMONA**

EMR course is 12 weeks in duration and a flexible schedule will be set to meet students and instructor requirements. The students will receive 6 credits upon successful completion of the course. Blended learning: the theory portion of the EMR program uses web based instruction and evaluation combined with seven face-to-face days (56 hours). Lab days will focus on hands on skills development with a final skills testing lab day.

**Note :** Carstairs may also be offering this course. Each site needs 10 participants to run this course.

The **prerequisite** for the course is that students must have a **Standard First Aid card and a Health Care Provider CPR card.** If you want more information please call me. SAIT offers the course (CPRS 225) at a cost of \$155.00. Cards must be current on the day of the course. (Standard First Aid Card must be within 3 years and Health Care Provider within 1 year).

Instruction will take place on weekends and commences mid September. Please call Cremona CES for more information!
