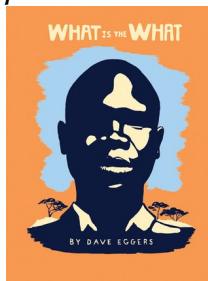

SENIORS HOUSING FOR CARSTAIRS, CREMONA AND WATER VALLEY AREAS

A group of volunteers is actively working in the area to promote awareness of the need for a new seniors housing facility to serve the Carstairs, Cremona and Water Valley areas. The facility we are working towards will be similar to the new one opened recently in Sundre and will be operated by Mountain View Seniors Housing...a partnership supported by Mountain View County and the 5 urban municipalities within it's boundaries. The proposal requires approval and considerable grant funding from the Province but we feel it is desperately needed to support the needs of seniors in our area for now and for years to come. The advocacy group has been working to raise public awareness of the need but also has been lobbying provincial officials for their support.

We are hoping for a positive announcement in the coming months and MVSH is ready to move forward as soon as funding is available.

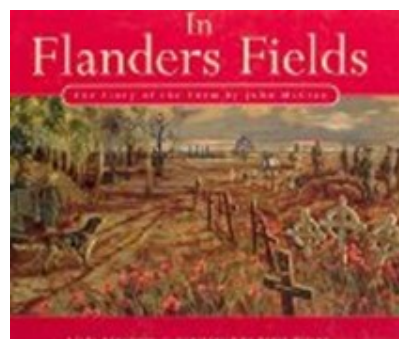
