H2S ALIVE

This course is intended for all workers in the petroleum industry who could be exposed to hydrogen sulphide (H2S). The primary focus is to work safely in and around H2S environments.

This course covers:

Physical Properties of H₂S, Health Hazards of H₂S, How to protect oneself from H₂S

Each employee is required to:

Operate a self-contained breathing apparatus, A detector tube device, Perform rescue breathing, Perform rescue techniques

An industry standard certificate valid for three years is issued upon successful completion of a written examination and demonstration of the required skills with a minimum score of 70%.



Note: Course starts at 8:30 am sharp. Students who are late may be refused admission. It is recommended that ladies wear slacks or jeans.
