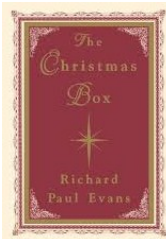

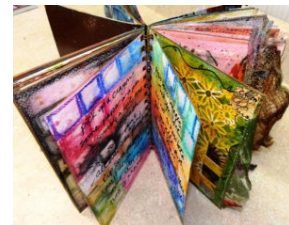
THE CHRISTMAS BOX by Richard Paul Evans

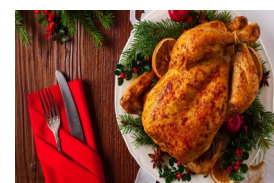
