
LIBRARY MOUSE by Daniel Kirk


FRANKLIN'S LIBRARY BOOK by Sharon Jennings

When Franklin loses a library book, he dons a disguise to hide from Mrs. Goose, and then retraces his steps.




LIBRARY LION by Michelle Knudsen

A lion starts visiting the local library but runs into trouble as he tries to both obey the rules and help his librarian friend.




CURIOUS GEORGE VISITS THE LIBRARY by Martha Weston
