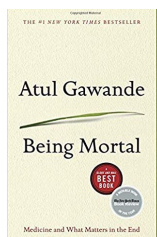

Being Mortal by Atul Gawande

JOIN OUR EXCITING NEW PROGRAMS



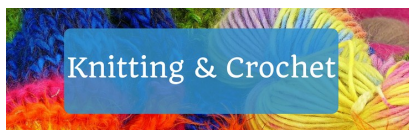
Thursdays 3pm-4:30pm ages 10 and up
