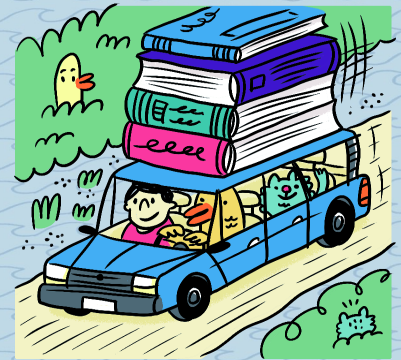
IT'S SUMMER READING PROGRAM TIME AGAIN AT THE CREMONA LIBRARY!
